These materials are designed as a support tool for students to continue their learning and engage in familiar activities essential to their learning and wellbeing.</p> <p><b>Curriculum resources</b></p> <p><a href="#">Curriculum resources</a>, including year and subject specific tasks and activities are available for students to complete away from school at their own pace.</p> <p>A teacher-directed <a href="#">eLearn (Blackboard)</a> course is available that contains Curriculum into the Classroom Independent Learning Materials and supporting resources from Prep to Year 10 in English, Mathematics, Science and HASS (History and Geography).</p> <p>Two-week units of work, for Prep to Year 10 across English, Mathematics, Science, Digital Technologies, Design and Technologies and the HASS subjects of History and Geography are being progressively released. These are available in both <a href="#">downloadable</a> and <a href="#">print</a> formats.</p> <p><b>Continuity of teaching and learning and business operations</b></p> <p>The Department of Education has a number of online tools and resources to support schools to ensure continuity of learning during events such as bushfire, floods and the recent COVID-19 pandemic. **Learning Place access issues with Chrome v80 and Microsoft Edge v80**  
Students using un-managed devices (e.g. non-MOE, BYOx and personal) **will have issues** accessing some sections of Learning Place using the new update of Google Chrome (version 80) and Microsoft Edge (version 80). The department is working towards a resolution.

Chrome version 80 and Microsoft Edge version 80 users will not be able to access:

- Some resource links within eLearn courses and edStudio – Install an alternative browser e.g. Firefox

**Trouble shooting**

The Learning Place website states ...

**“Departmental websites and applications issues with Chrome v80**

Staff, students and the public using un-managed devices (e.g. non-MOE, BYOx and personal) will have issues accessing some departmental applications and websites using Google Chrome v80. The department is working with Google to resolve these browser issues introduced by the new version upgrade.

Chrome v80 users will not be able to access:

- CAMS
- Learning Place resources (e.g. searching from Staff and Student sites)
- some resource links within eLearn courses and edStudios.

For CAMS, Staff and Student sites links to Learning Place resources, users should continue to use Internet Explorer 11 or Safari on Mac. Access will be available to eLearn using Chrome v80.”
