This funding will be used to

- Increase in NAPLAN results – 95% of all eligible students are at or above NMS in Reading and Numeracy
- 50% of eligible Year 3 students and 35% of eligible Year 5 students in Upper 2 Bands in Reading and Numeracy
- Continue to develop Individual Learning Plans for students who are below the National Minimum Standard
- Increase % of A's and B's in English and Mathematics from Prep – Year 6.

Our initiatives include

- Conduct Year Level Data Audits with teachers in the analysis and application of learning data to inform learning goals & targets
- Conduct Year Level Curriculum Planning - ACARA.
- Engage a Growth Mindset Teacher to work with students with their own Well Being, Goal Setting to build Resilience / Mindfulness through Yoga
- Employ a Teacher to implement Intensive Teaching Program for U2B
- Employ a Teacher to develop School Based Programs (Critical and Creative Thinking / Digital Pedagogies) and relief for teachers
- Employ Full time Teacher Aides in Prep for consistency
- Embed processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support PD and encourage reflective practice
- EAL/D Support.
